August Meeting Minutes...

Siouxland Woodturners August 7th, 2021 Meeting Minutes

The August meeting at Harrisburg High School was called to order at 1:04 by President Jeff Albrecht. There were 19 turners attending. Introductions were made.

Minutes of last meeting: June minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer's report: Jack reported that there is approximately \$2400 in the treasury. Some kits for the Fall classes were purchased.

Education Committee report: John W has arranged for Fall classes to be held at McCrossan Boys Ranch (building 8). A key to the shop building has been provided for our use once again. Fall classes will include four Woodturning 101 classes (on 9/14, 9/16, 9/21 and 9/23). Thereafter, a Duck Call class, a Natural Edge Bowl class, a Kitchen Gadgets class (pizza cutter, ice cream scoop, honey dipper, rolling pin, etc.), and an Office Gadgets class (pens, letter opener, magnifying glass, smartphone holder) will be held. Classes are on each Tuesday and Thursday for a four-week period. John is working on plans for scheduling of class mentors.

There may be classes/turning time available (maybe on a weeknight at the Ranch) for Club members during the Sept 14-Oct 7 timeframe. We would just have to let the Ranch know.

Motion made and passed to hold next meeting at McCrossan Boys Ranch, Sept 9th at 6:30 PM.

Membership Committee report: No report. If you have paid your dues and need a name badge, let Royce know. If you need a replacement name badge, please see Royce.

Equipment/Purchasing Committee report: We have everything needed for classes. Each student will have everything they need at each lathe station.

Library report: No report. Rex is assisting Steve.

Technology Committee report: No report.

The SWAT Symposium in Waco TX is scheduled for August 27-29. As of August 1, the convention center where it will be held is fully open. Doug has room for one person if you need a ride.

The Downtown Sioux Falls Art Festival is on September 11th.

New Business:

Royce announced an Art Festival scheduled for August 21 in Pearson IA. The organizer would like new vendors and the cost is \$15/booth. 500 – 1000 people are expected to attend. Dennis has two older Delta mini-lathes that he has reconditioned and will be giving away (to a beginning woodturner, perhaps) in the near future. Stan Houston has someone who has an older Powermatic lathe and a 5 gal. pressure tank available to buy (John Weaver is interested)




Tony's goose and duck calls Four goose and duck calls made by Fowl Fooler, Big River and Lohman. These calls were used by Tony Dean for field hunts.
