Siouxland Woodturners JANUARY 6, 2024 Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 1:00 PM by President Aaron Salberg

30 Members and guests were present and introduced themselves.

It was moved by John Olson, seconded and passed by voice vote to accept the minutes from the November meeting. (There was no official business meeting in December).

A review of the Treasurer's report was presented with an ending balance of \$2979.12.

Rex presented a check for \$154.66 for sale of magazines. Ranah donated this amount to the treasurer in Jim's name

It was moved by John Olson and seconded that the Treasurer's Report be accepted. The motion was passed by voice vote.

Discussion of how many members we would like to see in the club. If we outgrow our meeting room we will have to find a new place to have business meetings, etc.

We have brochures in the trailer but probably need to print more.

Our membership at the present time is about 50.
